WE ARE THRILLED TO ANNOUNCE THE NEXT SEMESTER OF AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAMMING (ASP)!

If you would like your child to participate in ASP, here are some things to know:

1. There is no additional cost to attend ASP
2. ASP is optional and is open to all students who are showing **safe and kind** behavior and can **stay with the group without 1:1 support**.
 - Participating students may attend Tuesdays and/or Thursdays
3. ASP will take place on Tuesdays and Thursdays after school from 3:15 pm – 5 pm.
 - Each group will meet **1 day/week (Tuesdays or Thursdays)** for a **semester**
 - Besides Shakespeare Slam – which meets both days (see below)
 - Each fall semester group will have **9 or 10 sessions**
 - **Fall Tuesdays:** October 10, 17, 24, 31 (after Halloween Party), November 7, 14, 21, 28, December 5, 12
 - **Fall Thursdays:** October 12, 19, 26, November 2, 9, 16, 30 (NO ASP 11/23 – Thanksgiving), December 7, 14
4. Parents must provide transportation home at 5 pm
 - Rideshare will only be permitted for students ages 18+
 - Carpool or non-parent pick up will be allowed with signed consent.
5. ASP will be led by O-School staff members
6. ASP is not open to TLC students, who have their own separate activities and programs.
