Update on Tomas Majetic Journey at the US Open


Former FHS student Tomas Majetic and Charlie Cooper from Palm Springs on US Open boys wheelchair doubles Finalist!!!



Tomas is currently training in Boulder, with **Rocky Mountain Training Center** and the founders of **RMTC are proud to have developed the 5430 Kids Tennis Foundation.** This foundation has worked with elementary schools across BVSD for 10 years, providing free tennis classes to introduce the sport to young children. Additionally, it offers program scholarships to kids who have a passion for tennis but come from families in need. Tomas was 'discovered' through the Net Generation junior wheelchair initiative just three years ago, and he is now one of the best junior players in the world!

Attention 9th - 12th graders!



Are you bilingual?

Are you <u>NOT</u> on track to take a level V world language course by the time you graduate?

Are you NOT on track to take a world language AP or IB exam?

If you answered "yes" to all three of those questions, please contact me asap.

I may be able to help you earn the **Seal of Biliteracy** by helping you sign up for the STAMP test (a roughly 2-4 hour world language test to be administered at Fairview). Most students who earn the Seal of Biliteracy do so, in part, by taking a level V world language class or by taking a world language AP or IB exam, but another way to do it is by taking the STAMP test. I don't want any bilingual students who are not in AP/IB/level 5 world language classes to miss out on the opportunity to earn the Seal of Biliteracy. Take the STAMP.

Seal of Biliteracy earners . . .

• are given a cool green cord to wear at graduation

- receive a fancy certificate
- get a special biliteracy recognition on their final transcript
- will potentially be recognized by prospective employers and colleges as having the fantastic, marketable skill of bilingualism
