**ARMED FORCES RECRUITER ACCESS TO STUDENTS AND
STUDENT RECRUITING INFORMATION**

Under the provisions of the Federal Every Child Succeeds Act and No Child Left Behind Act of 2001 the District is required to provide student information, upon request, to military recruiters. The law also permits families to “opt-out” of making their student’s information available.

The Miller Place School District will administer this Act using the “opt-out” procedure, i.e. it is presumed by the District that student contact information will be given to recruiters unless parents take the initiative to opt out. To this end, the District will adhere the following procedure:

1. Be sure the opt-out notice is appropriately advertised and circulated to all families by distributing a letter (sample attached #5306-R) in its own separate mailing.
2. Be sure the notification letter is translated into a language used by parents and written so people can understand it.
3. Require all students, Juniors and Seniors, to return the form whether they plan to opt out or not.
