**ARMED FORCES RECRUITER ACCESS TO STUDENTS AND
STUDENT RECRUITING INFORMATION REGULATION**

This is to inform you that a provision of the federal Every Child Succeeds Act (ECSA) and No Child Left Behind Act of 2001 (“NCLB”) require the school district to provide students’ names, addresses and telephone numbers to military recruiters when requested.

However, the Federal Law also states that school must notify parents and students (18 years or older) that they have the right NOT to be included when information is released if they choose.

To exercise your legal right to have this information kept private, you should use the form below to notify the school office that you do not wish this information to be released. Please note that unless you use this “opt out procedure” the school district cannot refuse the military recruiters’ requests and your child may be contacted by them.

To OPT OUT of the Military Recruitment Provisions of the ECSA and NCLB Act, please complete this form and return it to Miller Place High School Main Office by September 30 each school year. You may submit this form in person, by mail, by your student or by fax (#).
