Juniors and Seniors – Do you want to become a pilot? Join the **Museum of Flights Aeronautical Science Pathway (ASP) program.** This program is designed for high school juniors and seniors who want to become professional pilots or work in one of many aviation operations management fields, such as unmanned aerial systems, air traffic control, airport management, or airline dispatch. Six college-level courses will be embedded within each yearlong course, all of which are core to earning an Associate and a Bachelor of Applied Science degree in Aeronautical Science at Green River College. Seniors – Youth Aerospace Program is a two-year internship opportunity for students interested in the aerospace industry. This program is held at both Renton Technical College in Marysville and Everett Community College. Students are required to attend weekend activities and workshops during their senior year of high school. Students will also have the chance to take field trips to aerospace companies like Boeing, network with industry experts, and more. Students – Do you love books, reading, and research?
