TUBERCULIN SKIN TEST

Section 49406 of the Education Code requires that public school employees must have “proof” of “Freedom from TB” on file with the school district(s) in which they work. Section 3450 of the Health & Safety Code also requires this proof from employees and volunteers working in parochial and private elementary or secondary schools or any nursery school.

The Tuberculin Skin Test takes two visits – so plan your time accordingly. If you miss the second visit, the test must be repeated.

The district will accept adequate proof of freedom from TB provided the examination has been conducted within no greater than a 60-day period preceding the date of employment. If transferring from another school district, PVSD will accept evidence of current clearance.

If you have had a positive Tuberculin Skin Test in the past 20 years, you cannot have a repeat skin test. You will need to make arrangements for a chest x-ray.

Be sure you take the “Freedom from Tuberculosis Verification” form provided by the Human Resources Office with you to a medical office of your choice. The following is listed for your information:
