PREPARING TO COME TO CAMPUS

Health & Safety:

- If your child is showing ANY symptoms of Covid-19, they may not come to campus.
- [SYMPTOMS OF COVID-19](#) (pg. 11 at bottom of page) Symptoms include a fever higher than 99.5 with a no touch thermometer or 100.4 with other thermometer.
- If your child shows any symptom(s) of Covid-19 on campus, your child will wait in the isolation room.
 - You will need to pick up your child within an hour.
 - We will be calling home for any/all symptoms. We ask in advance for your understanding. For the safety of our school community, please note that we take this very seriously. Thank you.

Safety & Behavioral Expectations:

- Adults on campus will wear their masks while indoors.
- Students will wear masks indoors; in designated mask areas outside such as in hallways or by lockers; and outside when within 6 feet of others.
- Staff and students may remove masks outdoors when maintaining 6 foot (or more) physical distance from others.
 - If they are standing or sitting closely to one another, they will need to wear masks even outside. **If a student intentionally chooses to ignore these expectations, we will be calling you to pick up your child from school.**
 - It would be incredibly helpful to us if you can go over these expectations with your child. A particular area of need is reminders from you that students must wear a mask outside when within 6 feet of others. Our students enjoy standing closely while talking with one another. They will need a mask on to do so.

COMING TO CAMPUS

Instructional Plan:

School begins on Wednesday, August 25, 2021 for all PVSD students. This year, students will attend school 5 days a week, Monday thru Friday. (Woo Hoo!)

Back to School Night: Parents will have a chance to meet teachers during this year's virtual Back to School Night. More details to follow.

Student Schedules/1st Period Class:

- Middle school students' schedules should be visible in Parent Connect on the evening of Monday, Aug. 23.
- **To find the room number of their 1st period class**, in Parent Connect, look under "Schedule."
 - UNCLICK "Show All."
 - A room number would look like A2, B4, F2, for instance.
- Each student should have 8 class periods. Please note that schedule adjustments may occur on the first days of school.
 - All students attend Math/English Language Arts/Science/History/Elective/PE/Advisory.
 - Students will attend 3 academic classes and Advisory each day and rotate on an Odd/Even rotation.
 - First student day 8/25/21 is an "odd day" and students will go to periods 1, 3, 5 (Advisory), & 7. On "even days" students will go to periods 2, 4, 6 (Advisory) & 8.
- Students will receive a print out of their schedule in their 1st period class.
- If students were unable to locate their 1st period room number online we will have people at the gates and in the quad to assist if they know their 1st period teacher's name. We strongly advise locating the 1st period room information before coming to campus on the first day of school, Aug. 25.

Bell Schedules:

- Please note that every day, but Thursday, dismissal is at 3:05 pm.
- **Thursday dismissal is at 2:05 pm every week.**

Drop-off Times and Gate Entrances:

Gates will open at 8am. The first bell rings at 8:15, and class begins at 8:30. You may consider using the areas surrounding campus as potential drop-off locations and having your child walk onto campus.

Gates Open for Drop-Off:

- F Gate
- M- Gate
- Burnley St Gate - BACK gate will be open this year as well. Students may use this gate if it is most convenient

When dropping your child off on campus, please be safe and pull all the way around to the F gate to let your child out. The M gate will also be open to accommodate more students. Please be mindful of traffic flow. If students are walking/riding bikes or skateboards, they should use the crosswalk to cross Lantana street and proceed to F Gate or M Gate.

As students enter campus, we will do a welcome wellness check and temperature check for at least the first 60 days of school. As we will be welcoming almost 800 students on to campus each morning, please remember that students must wear a mask when within 6 feet of others even when outside.

We will re-evaluate the campus entrance procedures as needed to ensure timeliness and safety.

Visual Assessment at Gate:

- A campus supervisor or school staff member will be doing a visual assessment and temperature check of your child to determine safe entrance to school.

ONCE ON CAMPUS:

Before class begins:

- Students may safely socialize in the quad, at the lunch tables, or by their lockers until the first bell at 8:15.
 - Outside, students may remove their masks if they are physically distancing. If they are at their lockers, or standing within 6 feet of others, they will be required to wear their masks.
 - When the first bell rings at 8:15, students will go to their first period class.
 - Masks are required in the classrooms and in all buildings.
- Students will enter the classroom where the teacher will do a visual assessment of each student.

Classroom Space:

- Masks are required in the classroom and in all buildings while on campus.
- Teachers will allow masks breaks and can even utilize our outdoor spaces for class as needed.
- Students will use wipes to clean off their desks between class periods. (They will not use wipes at 1st period as each room would have been cleaned the previous evening.)

Nutrition:

- Continuing this year, all students can receive free nutrition and lunch, or they may bring their own.
- Students may safely socialize during nutrition in the quad or lunch table areas.
- They can take masks off if they are 6 ft. apart.
 - They must wear masks when socializing within 6ft. of each other.

Lunch:

- Continuing this year, all students can receive free nutrition and lunch, or they may bring their own.
- We will have 2 lunch periods determined by the student's Advisory teacher.
- Students will eat 6 to a table and/or on the grass/stage near the tables.
- After 10 minutes, students will then be dismissed to the field and blacktop.
- Admin and campus supervisors will be monitoring throughout each lunch.

Water Fountains

- Water fountains continue to remain off to prevent the spread of germs.
- Hydration stations to e-fill water bottles are working. **Please encourage your child to bring a reusable water bottle daily.**

Lockers:

- **Locker areas are considered required mask areas** due to the close proximity to one another.
- Lockers are optional as most textbooks are online.

Parent Volunteers:

- During the regular school day, staff and students will be on campus at this time, as well as a small number of volunteers. Additional volunteers will be permitted onto campus for special events, such as fundraisers. Physical Education:

- Students will change into PE clothes this year.
 - Students will have masks on at all times in the PE locker rooms.
 - PE Clothes can be purchased during the first weeks of school.

End of School Day:

- **Please consider using the areas surrounding campus as potential pick-up locations.**
- Students are encouraged to exit out of the gate closest to their last period class or nearest their locker, but they are welcome to use the back gate this year if it is more convenient.
- If coming into the parking lot to pick up, please pull all the way forward or find a parking spot. **DO NOT STOP AND WAIT.** This backs up the flow of traffic in/off of campus.
- Supervision will be placed strategically throughout campus.
- **Students must walk bikes, scooters, & skateboards on school property.**
- **Students must use crosswalks to cross the street (it's the law).**
