

HMS SAFETY WEEK

The safety of our students and security of the building has always been a priority for our school and Hamden Public Schools. By state law, we practice drills monthly; however, a special week was created within the District to increase awareness of school safety. As such, the week of September 18th will be known as "Safety Week" in Hamden Public Schools. During this week, all schools will practice specific safety drills daily to reinforce the importance of being prepared and knowing the expectations during an emergency situation.

In addition to these drills, staff members have participated in ALICE training (a nationally recognized program that provides proactive options in a situation involving a violent intruder) and other precautions that have been taken to secure our school buildings. Our school and District Safety Committees also periodically review

our emergency operations plans to ensure they are as current as possible.

In the event of an actual emergency, our first priority is to ensure safety, account for all students and staff and then, reunite students with families. Note that in an actual emergency you would receive additional information from the school and the District.

We realize school safety can be a sensitive issue, and our efforts to prepare children include discussing matters of safety in age-appropriate ways with students. First and foremost, we teach children the importance of being quiet and listening to the adults in charge, and we ask parents to reinforce that message. Though we cannot predict the future, we want to ensure that students and adults at Hamden Middle School are prepared. If you have any questions, please don't hesitate to contact the school.
