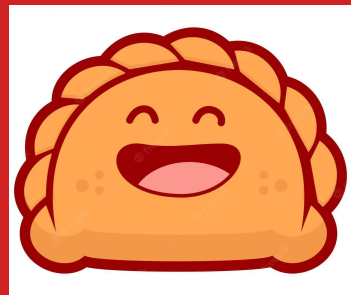
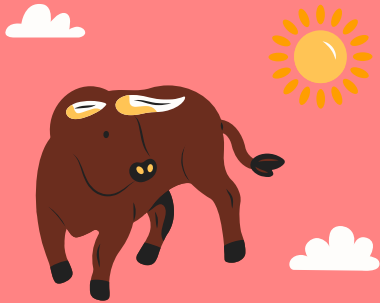

We have many exciting and interesting roles to fill within the Yearbook Club this year!

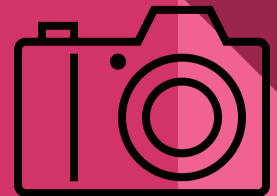

Talent Show

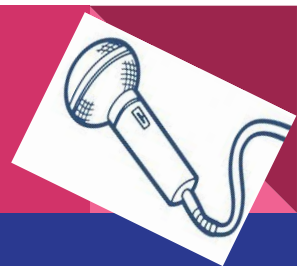

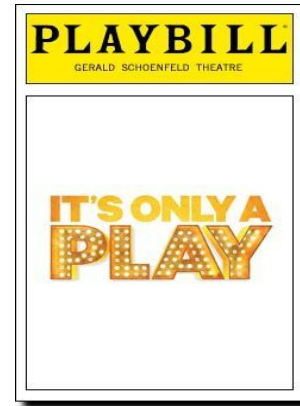
