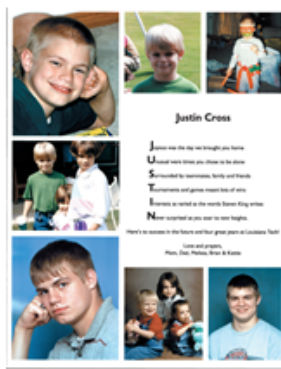

You will then be able to choose the ad design, upload your images, and type your message. Once you have finished, you will have the opportunity to proof your ad before you pay and submit the ad for production.
