From dreams to reality, a new chapter begins at Nottingham Elementary as part of the 2017 Bond Project

As the beginning of the school year draws near, enthusiastic Spring Branch ISD staff eagerly prepare to welcome back students. This year, the excitement is electric at one elementary where teachers and staff anticipate returning to class at a brand-new school.

Nottingham Elementary Principal Becky Hagan can hardly contain her excitement, "we are thrilled to move into the new Nottingham Elementary! Our students will have access to wonderful learning spaces that will foster their growth and inspire their limitless curiosity. It is going to be an incredible year!"

This new campus is made possible through the 2017 Bond Program, which received overwhelming approval from 80% of the voters in November 2017. This program builds upon the success of the 2007 Bond Program and continues the transformation of district facilities.



The school's design showcases collaborative areas that extend learning beyond the confines of traditional classrooms and open spaces filled with abundant natural light. It seamlessly blends with the surrounding neighborhood, becoming a cornerstone of the community.

The grand opening of the new Nottingham Elementary is scheduled for September 27, an event that the entire SBISD community will celebrate.

This is just one of the many projects in the 2017 Bond, which aims to replace the nine oldest elementary schools and one middle school. Additionally, it provides much-needed renovations to classrooms and facilities and various other upgrades across the district.

"We are incredibly grateful to the voters who supported the 2017 Bond Project," added Hagan. "Our school is beautiful and I can't wait to see all the learning that will take place within these walls."

The following 2017 Bond projects are currently underway:

- **Pre-K Centers Project:** The five Pre-K Centers classroom door hardware was changed out this summer. The new classroom door hardware have the "open/closed" notification.
- Elementary School Furniture: The installation of student and teacher classroom furniture at Buffalo Creek ES, Cedar Brook ES, and Treasure Forest ES completed summer of 2023.
- **Meadow Wood Elementary School**: Office addition and library renovation work completed summer of 2023.
- Memorial Drive Elementary School Replacement Project: In Construction Phase Project is on schedule.
- Nottingham Elementary School Replacement Project: In Construction Phase New campus opened August 2023. Grand Opening Event to be held September 27, 2023.
- Sherwood Elementary School Replacement Project: In Design Phase Project is on a revised schedule. A follow-up PAT meeting will be scheduled this fall.
- Spring Shadows Elementary School Replacement Project: In Procurement Phase The project process will begin earlier than scheduled. The PAT meetings are tentatively scheduled to begin September 2023.
- **Woodview Elementary School Replacement Project:** In Construction Phase Project is on a revised schedule.
- **Memorial Middle School Renovation Project:** Phase 2 of the renovation project completed fall of 2023.
- Northbrook Middle School Renovation Project: In Construction Phase Project is on schedule to be completed the early 2024.
- Spring Branch Middle School Reroofing Project: In Construction Phase The project is on schedule. This is a two-phased project to be accomplished over the next two summers.




