Dear Hawk Students, Families, and Friends:

Recently, I met with all four grades and discussed what it means to ELEVATE. We all play our own roles in school - parent, teacher, friend, student, and so on. One of the important aspects of creating a strong school is CO-Elevating, meaning that we're in this together. To illustrate this point, I brought up a fable from Aesop, a Greek storyteller, called the "The Four Oxen and the Lion." I first heard this fable when I was in infantry school so many years ago, and shared it with classes and teams that I have worked with over the years. You can read the fable here:

"A Lion used to prowl about a field in which Four Oxen used to dwell. Many a time he tried to attack them; but whenever he came near they turned their tails to one another, so that whichever way he approached them he was met by the horns of one of them. At last, however, they fell a-quarrelling among themselves, and each went off to pasture alone in a separate corner of the field. Then the Lion attacked them one by one and soon made an end of all four."

I explained to students that we, as a school community, are the oxen. There are a lot of forces that try to pull us apart, but if we want to accomplish our goals as individuals and as a school, we've got to stick together. We are better together.

I am so proud to be the principal of this amazing school. We have an incredible staff, incredible kids, and an incredible community. Thank you for your continued trust and support of us.

PSAT/NMSQT

On October 19, ALL Juniors will be taking the PSAT/NMSQT at no cost. The school will be covering the cost of the exam. This is our commitment and investment to give our students experience in taking high-stakes tests that they will come across in their future. A successful

score on the PSAT/NMSQT also gives students the opportunity to earn recognition and scholarships through the National Merit Scholarship program.

If you do not want your student taking the exam, please let us know. It is a logistical challenge for us to put this test together, so having an accurate count of students is important.

The PSAT/NMSQT is now digital! The test is easier to take, shorter, has more time per question, and comes with a built-in calculator. It can also qualify you for the National Merit Scholarship Program and other scholarships.

One thing that is certain is there are rules in life, in the workplace, on the road, and so on that we must all abide by. To get the most of our time together - students learning, teachers teaching - students must be in class. The below graphic explains the breakdown of this very simple policy.

Don't worry about the consequences, just stay in class.

If you are worried about consequences, if you are out of class without a pass, it is an automatic lunch detention.

Stay-In-Class Policy



Why:

- Keep students in class as much as possible to focus on learning
- Responding effectively and quickly to students out of class without permission and/or students not going to class
- Providing a consistent method for Staff and Administrators to address students in the halls and out of class
- Increase the percentage of students attending class
- Decrease the percentage of students skipping class
- · Reinforce to students the importance of being in class

School-Wide Agreements

- · One student out of class at a time
- · No leaving class in the first ten minutes of class
- · No leaving class in the last ten minutes of class
- Students do not leave until excused by teacher (on or after the bell)


