Dear Student and Parent/Guardian,

Ramapo College of New Jersey will be offering Dual Enrollment Credit for **Mindfulness Based Stress Reduction Seminar (CNST 240) at Henry P. Becton Regional High School** for Fall 2023 enrollment. This program offers qualified students the opportunity to earn two college credits for the course offered at their high school. The tuition rate is **\$132.45 per credit totaling \$264.90** for the course, which is a **savings of nearly 75% off a traditional Ramapo College course!**

The deadline to apply is Monday, October 2 with a payment deadline of Wednesday, October 4. You will complete the Non-Degree Application using the "How to Apply for Ramapo College Dual Enrollment Program Fall 2023 Guide". **Reminders:** As you are completing the Non-Degree Application you must select "Dual Enrollment Student" or your application will not be processed with the discounted Dual Enrollment rate. As a Dual Enrollment Student, you will not be required to complete Academic School History or Document Uploads sections. You also will not have to pay the \$25.00 non-refundable application fee that other Non-Degree students have to submit.

Your application will be processed within 2-3 business days. Once the application has been processed, you will receive an email with the subject "Status Update: Your Ramapo College Application". You will have to log back into your Ramapo College application portal to view your next steps: activating your Ramapo College email address and payment instructions for the course. Frequently Asked Questions:

Will I have to attend class at Ramapo College?

The Dual Enrollment Program does not require students to attend any classes at Ramapo College.

Can you guarantee that the course will transfer to another college/university?

There is no assurance that these credits will transfer to another college/university or satisfy degree requirements at said college/university. Each institution has different transfer credit policies and it is the responsibility of the Dual Enrollment Student to understand the policies of the college/university the student wishes to attend.

Will I automatically be accepted to Ramapo College if I take Dual Enrollment courses?

Permission to register as a Dual Enrollment Student in no way suggests or implies that you will be admitted as a matriculated student to Ramapo College either now or in the future.

If I am admitted and decide to attend Ramapo College, will my Dual Enrollment courses automatically be accepted?

Credits earned through Ramapo College's Dual Enrollment Program are automatically accepted at Ramapo and will be applied to the student's degree audit upon being successfully admitted and enrolled in the College as a matriculated student in the future.

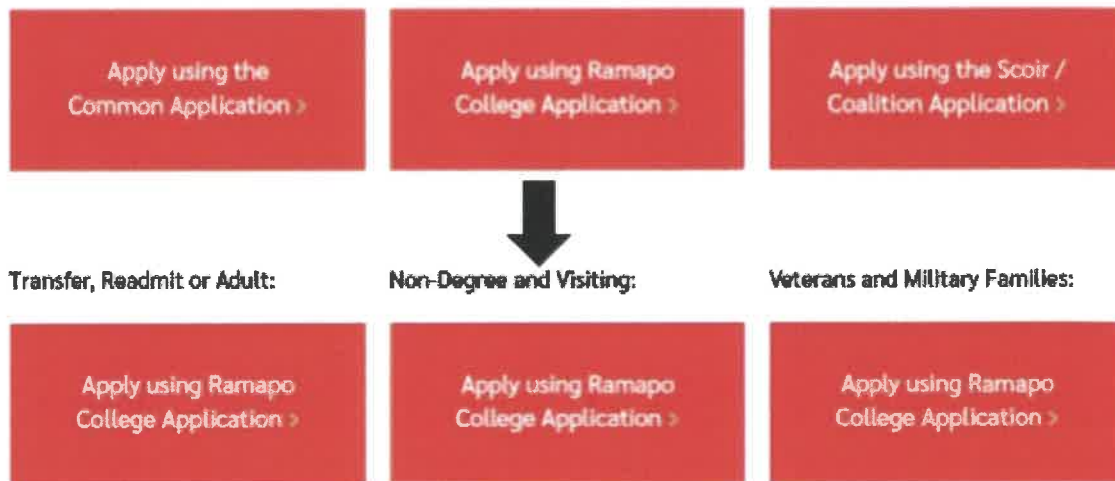


STEP 2


