CONCERT DRESS

Concert Choir, Sound Ideas, and Madrigals (all level 3 choirs) will purchase matching formal concert attire at the beginning of the school year. The cost will not exceed \$150. The order will be placed within the first 2 weeks of school and students will pay for their performance attire on myDSD.

Concert attire for Chorale, Soprano/Alto Choir, and Tenor/Bass Choir will be discussed in the first 2 weeks of school. Students in these choirs will be responsible for obtaining their specific attire. All efforts will be made to use items already in a student's wardrobe.

CLASS FEE

Students will have a fee for choir that will be put in myDSD. The fee breakdown is as follows:

- All Choirs: Choir t-shirt (\$15) Choir clinicians (\$5)
- Choir Level 2 & 3: State Choir (\$5) Transportation (\$5)
- Choir Level 3: Performance Attire (not to exceed \$150)

CONCERT TICKETS

In order to generate funds for new music, accompanists, and commissioned songs, we will continue using the system of reserved seating at concerts being an option for those who wish to use it. Free seating will always be available on a first-come, first-served basis making concerts accessible to everyone. *Concert tickets will only be needed for our concerts in December and May.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Students in choir levels 2 and 3, in addition to all students hoping to participate in Region Solo & Ensemble, must maintain a 2.0 GPA throughout the year, in addition to having no more than 1 F per quarter. Additionally, students cannot have a single U for citizenship. Since several of our events are sponsored by UHSAA, we are expected to adhere to the eligibility requirements.

Students who drop below a 2.0 may be ineligible to participate in specific events. Students in auditioned choirs who do not maintain above a 2.0 will be put on probation prior to determining if a student will need to forfeit their spot in the choir.
