

## Highland High School - Home School Student Contract 2021-2022



- Students must choose during registration at Highland High School if they intend to work towards a Highland H.S. diploma (Pathway A), or a homeschool diploma (pathway B).
  - Students CANNOT switch between pathways once a determination has been made.

In order to earn a Highland H.S. Diploma the student must:

- Take and earn a minimum of 15 credits at Highland H.S. (in-person classes) to earn a Highland H.S. diploma.
- Complete senior level classes (Economics, Civil Government, Language Arts IV or AP) at Highland H.S. in-person.
- Have completed courses that have been vetted and approved by CDE in order to have them apply towards a Highland H.S. diploma.
- Understand that the Highland H.S. counselor will verify incoming student transcripts for completion, grades, credit checks, etc.
- Understand that Highland H.S. reserves the right to test the student in any content area for proficiency and competency.
- Understand that homeschool courses will be added to their transcript as P/F, and earn no GPA.
- Students who elect to earn a homeschool diploma (pathway B) will not walk or participate in Highland H.S. graduation events, including the slideshow, graduation ceremony or senior graduation activities completed as members of the Highland H.S. graduating class.
