- **Elevate question asking skills** — a transferable ability that augments all learning
- **Create mutually respectful, sustainable reciprocal partnerships** — develop understanding of the importance of clarifying roles and responsibilities and meeting personal and group obligations
- **Reflect by choice on significant moments and learning** — and *enjoy* the process of reflection
- **Demonstrate what has been learned**, the process of learning, and what has been accomplished through service — resulting in a more astute and competent learner

We will also **explore curriculum planning for academic integration that aims for interdisciplinary connections, possible at all grade levels**. And we always experience **practical strategies that can be used immediately**. During our highly interactive time together, you are guaranteed takeaway strategies that elevate student participation and how they become catalysts for change.
