Ethan Anderson, J.L. Mann: Anderson passed for three touchdowns in the second half and finished with 307 yards in a 21-19 loss to Greenville.

Acie Hatfield, Christ Church: Hatfield stepped in at quarterback and led the Cavaliers' 51-0 win against Calhoun Falls by completing 8 of 9 passes for 184 yards and four touchdowns,

Brayden Johnson, St. Joseph's: Johnson had 11 carries for 126 yards and three touchdowns, all in the first half of a 61-12 win against Ware Shoals.

Avery McFadden, Hillcrest: McFadden had a pair of touchdowns catches Friday for Hillcrest football in a 52-14 win against Powdersville and is now the school's all-time leader with 26.

Kylar Zimmerman, Greenville: Zimmerman ran for 146 yards and two touchdowns in the Red Raiders' 21-19 win against J.L. Mann.
