Extra duty supplements will be paid in full amount sums when duties are completed and proper documentation is submitted to Central Office. Extra duty supplements \$2500 or greater will be paid over 24 pays for full time employees. Should the full time employee resign before completing supplemental duties, supplemental duty pay will be prorated.

Timesheets are submitted through the building secretary. Incomplete timesheets will be returned to the school to be revised. Failure to properly complete timesheets may delay pay until the next payroll.

All payroll is distributed via direct deposit according to a schedule and approved annually by the Board. Pay statements will be provided electronically via MUNIS self-service.

# Calculating Pay

Pay is annualized. Employees who are paid an hourly rate and are also contracted for a specific number of days and a specific number of hours per day will have their salary divided evenly over 24 paychecks even though the number of days worked during a pay period may differ.

# Classified Salary Notes

Bus driver field trip rate is \$13.00/ hr Driver/Trainer rate is an additional \$1.00/hr

Bus drivers may not exceed 15 hours of paid time in a 24 hour period. This may include up to 10 hours of driving and 5 hours of rest. (per US Dept of Transportation CDL regulations)

Student workers will be paid minimum wage + 25% for the 1st year and second year students workers additional \$1.00/hr.

A classified employee may carry years of experience from one Danville district classified position to another Danville district classified position. Years of experience may be granted from comparable positions outside the Danville District with HR approval. Credit for years of experience cannot transfer to or from certified to classified positions. The exception being teaching experience up to 10 years will count towards classroom instructional assistant positions. Additional experience may be granted by the Superintendent/Designee.

While working a temporary classified position other than your contracted position, staff are paid at step zero.

Drivers have the ability to earn a bonus each quarter. The opportunity to receive a larger bonus overtime happens with consistent attendance. The first quarter with perfect attendance is \$100. Two consecutive quarters with perfect attendance earns a \$150 bonus. Three consecutive quarters with perfect attendance earns a \$250 bonus. Four (all year) consecutive quarters with perfect attendance earns a \$300 bonus. This gives a driver the ability to earn \$800 extra for a year of perfect attendance.
