Faribault Public Schools is still currently following MDH/ CDC's isolation guide for schools (see below). In short, anyone who tests positive for COVID-19 must isolate themselves by staying home from school until all **three** of the following are true:

- 1. You are asymptomatic or symptoms are improving
- 2. It has been at least five days since you first felt sick **OR** tested positive, and
- 3. You have had no fever for at least **24** hours, without using fever-reducing medicine. Face coverings are still required by the Minnesota Department of Health for an additional **five** days for students and staff returning to school or work from isolation

Close contacts are not required to complete a quarantine period. It's strongly recommended they monitor for symptoms and stay home and seek testing if they're feeling ill.
