

Why Prepare?

Gaining admission to the college of your choice is more difficult than ever. That's why a high score on the ACT college entrance exam is so important. The ACT is a very unique and challenging test. Knowing what to expect and how to approach each section and type of question can increase scores significantly.

This 6-hour ACT preparation workshop is taught by Dr. Milt Dehn, a testing expert who has helped hundreds of students improve their ACT scores. Through hands-on practice, the workshop teaches specific test-taking strategies for each of the five ACT subject tests and the different types of questions found in each section.
