- Two new schools to accommodate rapid student growth in Goodyear and Buckeye
- District-wide facility, technology, and transportation upgrades vital for safety and security
- Site improvements to schools' roofing, flooring, plumbing, parking lots, landscaping, shaded structures, and fields
- Supplying schools with furniture and equipment
- Phase 2 District Complex

## ACCOMMODATING RAPID GROWTH

### GROWTH SINCE 2019

LESD25 has grown by approximately 834 students since 2019, which reflects a 23% increase in enrollment.

### PROJECTED ADDITIONAL GROWTH BY 2029

LESD25 projects student enrollment will increase by approximately 1,409 students by 2029, which would reflect a 32% increase in enrollment.


