#### **AP Literature and Composition:**

Course Description: The AP English Literature and Composition course provides the following literacy components: the experience of literature, the interpretation of literature, and the evaluation of literature. Students use literary analysis to examine, interpret, discuss, and write about works of prose and poetry. They will also deepen their understanding of literature by completing informal writing tasks such as free-writing, response writing, and annotation. Formal writing assignments will focus on the critical analysis of literature and will include expository, analytical, and argumentative essays. In addition to these writing tasks, students will prepare for the course final exam by writing essay responses under time constraints.

#### **AP Human Geography**

Course Description: The AP Human Geography course is equivalent to an introductory college-level course in human geography. The course introduces students to the systematic study of patterns and processes that have shaped human understanding, use, and alteration of Earth's surface. Students employ spatial concepts and landscape analysis to examine socioeconomic organization and its environmental consequences. They also learn about the methods and tools geographers use in their research and applications. The curriculum reflects the goals of the National Geography Standards and relies heavily on college-level texts, primary source documents, and outside readings. If Secondary I students want to enroll in AP Human Geography, they need to meet a set of criteria and

have a signed letter from parents. This course fulfills the World Geography graduation requirement.
