This informative workshop will provide attendees with all the information they need to enter **National Service through the AmeriCorps program**.

AmeriCorps is the program whereby citizens can ***Make A Difference*** in their community by enrolling to lend their energy and ability to advance a well thought out project and program. AmeriCorps members receive a stipend, fully paid health benefit (full time) and an education award that can be applied to any post-secondary school tuition/fees. **Member terms are full or part time and there are many opportunities available, including the Augusta area.**

The education award can be used to pay down your student loans or transferred (over 55) for the college expenses of a grandchild, child, or foster child.
