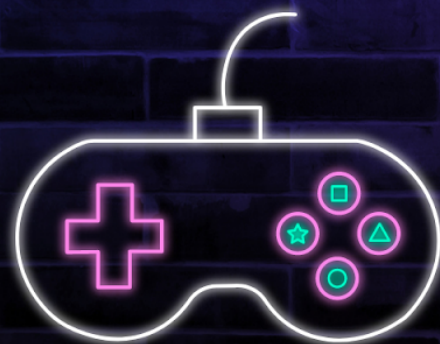

# Summer Youth Corps



**American  
Red Cross**

**Join the ranks to help save lives. Join the Summer Youth Corps program today and be on your way to having an epic summer.**

## *How old do I need to be to join?*

- Ages 16 and above (may vary in some regions), see American Red Cross Youth Guidelines below.
- Parental Consent Form required for those 17 and under.
- No experience necessary.

## *What will I do?*

- You could be scheduling other volunteers, assisting Blood Donor Ambassadors at blood drives, networking via social media with blood donors or supporting the team in the office.
- Assist with Closing the Sickle Cell Gap activities.

## *What is my promise to help the Red Cross?*

- We ask that you to volunteer 10 to 20 hours per month between May 15 and August 31.

## *When and where does the Red Cross need help?*

- Most blood drives take place during the day, Monday through Friday, and occasionally on weekends.
- You will provide your own transportation to the volunteer events that you choose.

## *How do I schedule?*

- Sign up with your supervisor or online and choose the locations and times that best fit your schedule.

## *How will I be trained?*

- Online training is mandatory. Links will be sent once accepted for the Summer Youth Corp.

## *What do I gain from the experience?*

- A letter of reference for your portfolio (great for college applications, future jobs, etc.).
- Documented community service hours.
- The ability to build your customer service skills and contribute to your community.
- The opportunity to work directly with medical or volunteer engagement staff.
- An official Red Cross name badge to wear while volunteering.

<b>Example: Volunteer Position Title</b>	<b>Youth Donor Ambassador: Ages 16+</b>
<b>Purpose</b>	Provide excellent and enthusiastic customer service to enhance the blood donor experience. Engage with blood donors to promote blood donation and set the stage for a long-term commitment to regular blood donations.
<b>Key Responsibilities at Blood Drives</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Welcome and greet donors, escort as necessary and assist with initial intake and hand offs through the blood donation process</li> <li>• Ensure blood donors have relevant information and that questions are answered appropriately</li> <li>• Learn and share the Red Cross story, including the mission, vision, and values</li> <li>• Create a favorable impression of the Red Cross, and the blood donation process, that will encourage continued support</li> <li>• Make reminder calls, reschedule donor appointments, and perform follow up activities as directed</li> <li>• Be available and committed to the volunteer schedule</li> <li>• Model excellent customer service behaviors</li> <li>• Attend to donors in the Hospitality Area, ensure each donor is recognized for his/her contribution</li> <li>• Set up and maintain cleanliness in Reception and Hospitality Areas</li> <li>• Punctual and dependable in arriving for assignment(s)</li> </ul>
<b>Qualifications</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Willingness to support the American Red Cross mission</li> <li>• Ability to display the utmost professionalism and communication skills</li> <li>• Extremely comfortable working with people from all walks of life</li> <li>• Ability to represent the American Red Cross to the community</li> </ul>
<b>Tools and Training</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Orientation to American Red Cross</li> <li>• Blood Drive Volunteer Training</li> </ul>
<b>Development Opportunities</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Gain valuable training and experience while providing an invaluable service to your community</li> <li>• Network and meet new people</li> <li>• Develop customer service skills that last a lifetime</li> </ul>
<b>American Red Cross Volunteer Youth Guidance</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The volunteer work assigned to youth should be performed in a non-hazardous environment</li> <li>• Youth Blood Services Volunteers: Individuals must have a profile in Volunteer Connection to be considered registered Red Cross volunteers. When completing the application process in Volunteer Connection, youth under 18 require a parental consent form</li> </ul>
