

This multiplatform journalism workshop is designed to expose you to a wide variety of media and their importance as tools for journalists in today's society. Xposure will bring together skills in reporting, writing, visual journalism (photo and video) and use of social media for each student, with a goal of producing a report on a subject of intense interest to today's youth and other news and feature stories.
