New Health Services for WCPS Families

WCPS recently announced a partnership with the Cumberland Family Medical Center to establish Healthy Kids Clinics in each Warren County school beginning January 4th, 2023. This will provide South Warren High School with a full-time nurse that will have authority to administer over-the-counter medication with parent/guardian permission. <u>This form</u> needs to be completed by a parent/guardian and submitted to our front office in order for their child to be seen at the clinic. Please return your HKC Registration Form to school as soon as possible.

We would like to point out that even if you do give permission on the registration form for your child to be seen by the nurse practitioner, you will be contacted and informed of the visit prior to your child seeing the nurse practitioner. Also, if you choose for your student(s) not to receive services through this program, the school nurse will no longer be able to do an illness assessment on your child(ren), such as temperature checks. For those choosing not to receive services, the school nurse <u>will be able</u> to administer daily medications (with parent/guardian permission), give the student a bandaid, or give the student an ice pack; no other services can be provided.




