

*HOMESCHOOLING DIPLOMA POLICY*

Students at the secondary level who have been approved for homeschooling and wish to enroll in the Lyon County School District to complete a high school program and obtain a diploma from the Lyon County School District must meet the following criteria:

1. The student must have been approved for homeschooling for the time that they were not attending a public or private school.
2. Only credits earned for courses offered by an accredited correspondence school approved by the State Board of Education will be accepted by the high school.
3. The student must complete all graduation requirements of the Lyon County School District, attend the high school for at least one full year immediately prior to graduation, and complete a minimum of six credits in order to be issued a diploma.
4. A minimum of six credits issued by the high school must be earned to complete the high school program. At least four of the six credits must be earned in subjects required for high school graduation and not in elective courses.
5. A student may not earn six credits, withdraw from the high school, and then earn the remaining credits through a correspondence program and be issued a school district diploma.
