

SCHOOL-SPONSORED DANCE POLICY

The Lyon County School District Board of Trustees recognizes the value of student social events and activities in enhancing and enriching the school experience for all students within the District.

The policy of the Board is that school facilities shall be made available for the conduct of social events so long as such events have been approved by the principal. It shall be the responsibility of the principal or their designee to ensure that appropriate staff will be available to provide adequate supervision of students attending these events.

All School-sponsored dances shall be held at school sites within the District unless specific exception is granted by the Board of Trustees. Under no circumstances may a School-sponsored dance be held at any location outside of the attendance area for that school.

As voluntary participants in school social events and activities, including School-sponsored dances, students shall be held responsible for compliance with all rules and regulations regarding student conduct. Any infractions of those rules will be subject to discipline as outlined in Policy JGA (Student Discipline Policy). Any student may be denied the privilege of participating in social events or activities if they have demonstrated disregard for the rules of student conduct.
