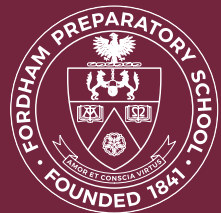




Commuting to Fordham Prep

The historic Rose Hill campus in the Bronx has been home to Fordham Prep for over 180 years. Easily accessible via multiple methods of transportation, the campus's unique environment and proximity to Fordham University distinguishes it from other high schools in the New York City area. **Fordham Prep students from over 150 different zip codes commute to Fordham Prep each day via public and private transportation.**

The Rose Hill campus is a short walk from Metro-North's Fordham and Botanical Garden stations; the Bx9, Bx12 and Bx22 bus stops; and the D and 4 subway lines.

Public Transit

FROM THE SOUTH

(Manhattan and Queens)

From Manhattan's West Side

Take the **D** train to the Fordham Road station stop. Transfer to the Bx12 bus or walk east down the hill to the Rose Hill Campus.

From Manhattan's East Side

Take the **4**, **5** or **6** train northbound to 125th Street. Transfer to Metro-North's Harlem or New Haven Line north to the Fordham Station.

Take the **4** train northbound to Fordham Road. Transfer to the Bx12 east to the Rose Hill Campus.

From Queens

Take the Q44 SBS bus to East Tremont Avenue and E 177th Street. Transfer to the Bx9 headed to Riverdale 262nd Street. Exit at the Fordham Plaza stop and enter the campus upon arrival.

FROM THE NORTH

(Fairfield, Putnam, and Westchester Counties)

Metro-North Harlem Line (BLUE)

Take a southbound train to the Botanical Garden train station. Upon exiting the train, proceed east to the Southern Boulevard entrance of the Rose Hill Campus.

You may also take a Harlem Line train to the Fordham station. Upon arrival, walk upstairs to Fordham Road. Turn left and walk to the Fordham Road entrance of the Rose Hill Campus.

Metro-North Hudson Line (GREEN)

Take a Southbound train to Harlem-125th Street and transfer to a northbound Harlem or New Haven line train. Exit at the Fordham station. Upon arrival, walk upstairs to Fordham Road. Turn left and walk to the Fordham Road entrance of the Rose Hill Campus.

Metro-North New Haven Line (RED)

Take a southbound train to the Fordham station. Upon arrival, walk upstairs to Fordham Road. Turn left and walk to the Fordham Road entrance of the Rose Hill Campus.



Commuting FAQs



Are you located inside of the Rose Hill Campus?

Yes, we are geographically located on the northwest section of the Rose Hill Campus. Security guards located at each entrance around the campus can direct you.

Do you provide bus/van services?

Shuttle bus service both to and from Fordham Prep each day is available from Manhattan's Upper West Side based on demand.

Do you provide MetroCards or discounted Metro-North passes?

Fordham Prep students who live in New York City are eligible to receive MetroCards through the New York City Department of Education. These are distributed directly to students at the beginning of the academic year.

Students that commute via Metro-North are eligible to take part in the Mail & Ride School Commutation program and receive a discount on their monthly train pass.

Is parking available on campus?

Fordham Prep uses the Fordham University parking lot located at the main entrance of the Rose Hill Campus for visitors and various events. Students that wish to drive may purchase a monthly pass to park in this lot. There is no parking at the Prep building for students.

What time does the school day start?

The building is open to students at 6:00 am. The school day begins at 8:25 am.

What time does the school day end?

Students are dismissed at 2:40 pm after which Consultation Period is offered to students who seek to meet with teachers. After-school activities and sports generally begin at 3:00 pm.
