OUR PROCESS

Strategic planning is a core responsibility of Lake Mary Preparatory School. During the 2019-2020 school year, Lake Mary Preparatory launched a comprehensive strategic planning process spearheaded by a Strategic Planning Committee consisting of a dedicated group of faculty, administration, students, and LMP families. The committee focused on research, SWOT analysis, surveys, industry trends and met with an external consultant with expertise in both international education and independent schools.

As strategic initiatives were identified, the strategic planning committee expanded upon each one to outline specific goals and strategies. After a year of steadfast work, the leadership team approved the strategic plan identifying four strategic initiatives that positively impact the long-term success of the school:

At Lake Mary Prep, we know strategic thinking is essential to our continued growth and improvement, and with ongoing evaluations and reporting, we can ensure that we are fulfilling our mission and holding true to our school's commitment to our faculty, students, and community.

TEACHING LEARNING

GOAL:

Develop an inquiry-based, differentiated and holistic curriculum that is more closely aligned with our mission statement.

STRATEGIES:

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- 1. Build a systematic approach to organizing and designing vertical standards and resources from PreK-3 through 12th grade through student outcomes.
- 2. Through targeted instruction, further develop logic, critical thinking, and communication skills in our K-8 math program.
- 3. Develop a school-wide culture of feedback rooted in trust, growth, and personal accountability.
- 4. Develop a robust and meaningful service-learning program to make a greater impact in our local and global community.
- 5. Create opportunities for students to further enhance their education outside the classroom.

GOAL:

Develop and sustain a financial plan to support the school's mission, continued development, and achieve fiscal independence.

STRATEGIES:

- 1. Develop a comprehensive financial plan and budget with the aim of maintaining the long-term financial stability of the school.
- 2. Create a monitoring and compliance system for ongoing financial support and guidance.
- 3. Develop a comprehensive athletic facilities plan to protect our current investments while planning for future investments through strategic planning and spending.
- 4. Continue to monitor and enhance retention and enrollment.
- 5. Create an advisory board to provide guidance and feedback for admissions decisions.
