FAFSA=

Free Application For Federal Student Aid

Application opens in December October 1st

File the FAFSA your senior year.

Check your college's financial aid deadline, they vary.

Many scholarships require you to submit the FAFSA as part of the application process. (i.e., Opportunity Scholarship)

Submit even if you do not qualify for a Pell Grant— you never know what you can get unless you apply.
