Accommodations/Food

We will be camping at the Rock N Water facility. Students will bring air mattresses and sleeping bags. Meals will be provided by Rock N Water.

Cost - \$700

The cost for this trip covers all travel, food, and activities. Meals on travel days may be an additional expense.

Application Process

The Lotus Service trip is open to all High School Students. To apply, please submit the 2024 Service Trip Online Application. The 2024 Service Trip Application is for current full-time students only. The link to this application will be posted on the Student Portal under the "Announcements." Applications will only be accepted during the following time frame: Thursday, September 21, through Monday, October 2. (Note: The application will no longer be available after 7:00p.m. on Monday, October 2).

Selection Process

The team will consist of a maximum of 64 students, plus 6 adult chaperones. After applications are submitted, participants will be selected based on the following trip-specific criteria: ability to work well alongside others, a servant's attitude, and willingness to make a difference. Be advised that it is a physically rigorous trip. Applicants must be open to being challenged and stretched outside of their comfort zone while maintaining a positive attitude. All applicants will be notified by October 31st.
