Dear Public Servant,

Holy Family High School awards one ***Freedom Scholarship*** per year to one incoming freshman in appreciation for your service to our community. Therefore, it is with great pleasure that Holy Family High School invites you to apply for this scholarship for your son or daughter beginning with the 2024-25 school year. This scholarship is one-half of the Catholic affiliated rate and is non-transferable. It is renewable for four years if the recipient maintains a GPA of 2.5 or better with no semester grade below "C" and is a positive, active member of the Holy Family High School community.

The family must meet the following criteria:

1. Parent or legal guardian must be an active Military, Military Veteran or First Responder (i.e., EMT, Firefighter, Police Officer, or Paramedic)
2. Commitment to Catholic secondary education and the teachings of the Catholic faith
3. Student has maintained a GPA of at least 2.5 with no grade lower than "C"
4. Good academic and school attendance records
5. **Financial need - The parent or legal guardian of the student must complete a FACTS Financial Aid Application**
6. Apply for admission to Holy Family High School and be accepted

Please complete the attached form, including three letters of recommendation for the student. To be considered, applications must be received at Holy Family High School by **Sunday, January 14, 2024**. HFHS will notify the recipient of this scholarship in February 2024.
