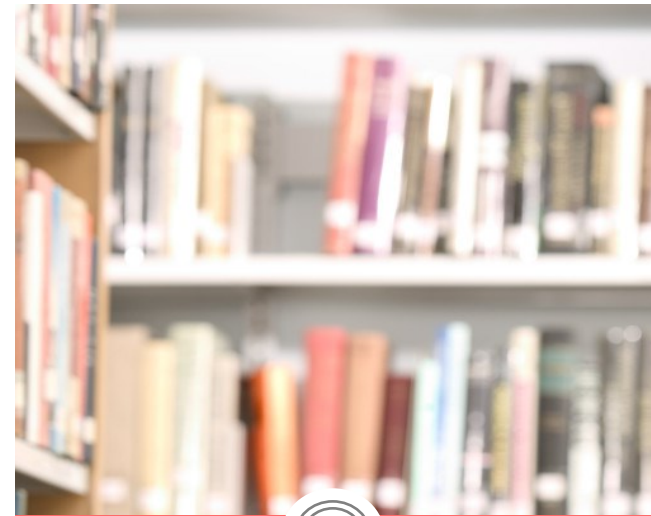
LEE COUNTY PRIMARY SCHOOL GOALS:
