Founded in 1965, Moreau Catholic is an independent, Catholic college preparatory institution sponsored by the Congregation of Holy Cross and fully accredited by the Western Association of Schools and Colleges for the maximum term possible. 791 students are currently enrolled in grades 9 through 12. **The Class of 2024 totals 204 students.** The ethnic composition of the student body is: 12% African-American; 40.9% Asian/Filipino; 7.2% European-American; 23.2% Hispanic/Latino; 2.9% Pacific Islander/ Hawaiian; 12.4% multiracial/other; 1.3% declined to state. A total of 222 students graduated in 2023.

Moreau Catholic is located in Hayward, a suburban Bay Area community with a population of 160,050 and serves Southern Alameda County. It is the sixth largest city in the San Francisco Bay Area. Students commute to Moreau Catholic High School from as far as Livermore (East), San Jose (South), Oakland, and Hercules (North).
