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


DISTRICT MATH MILESTONES EOG RESULTS




DISTRICT SCIENCE MILESTONES EOG RESULTS




DISTRICT SOCIAL STUDIES MILESTONES EOG RESULTS












OCONEE RESA 6TH GRADE ELA COMPARISON CHART













OCONEE RESA 5TH GRADE SCIENCE COMPARISON CHART




OCONEE RESA 8TH GRADE SOCIAL STUDIES COMPARISON CHART




OCONEE RESA AMERICAN LITERATURE COMPARISON CHART




OCONEE RESA BIOLOGY COMPARISON CHART




OCONEE RESA U.S. HISTORY COMPARISON CHART




OCONEE RESA 3RD GRADE MATH COMPARISON CHART










