1. International Food Fair Notes:

- a. The event was very successful. We raised 1,668 euros for the Green Roof Project. We had plenty of parent volunteers and over 20 countries were represented.
- b. We had some great parents and CAS helpers on Friday and Saturday. Using the senior campus cafeteria was a good choice as there was a lot of food on the floor that would have gotten on the OLC floor. It was recommended that we use the junior campus cafeteria next time as it might be larger if the audience stands are put away.
- c. The Green Roof project powerpoint presentation was on display for all to see. The four raffle donations and the one euro ticket price for food was well received.

2. Green Roof Project

- a. We are in need of a new leader and more group members for this project. There are currently 6 members, but 2 members are leaving including the leader. We are looking for parents that have good communication skills, possibly bilingual: (Dutch and English, but this is not required)
- b. Project members are currently working to finalise the architectural plans and cost with De Dakdokters and will need help with applying for funding.
- c. RISS PTA has already set aside 20,000 euros for the Green Roof Project plus the amount of 1,668 euros from the IFF fundraiser.
- d. It was discussed that we could provide an additional 5,000 or 10,000 euros for the project as we currently have almost 18,000 euros free budget not dedicated to any project in the PTA account that will roll over into next year if we do not use it this year. The group decided to vote on this at next month's meeting.

3. End of Year BBQ and Sports Day

- a. Sports Day is planned for Monday, July 3rd. PTA typically provides lunch for the students (sandwiches, drinks, fruit, snacks etc). We have set aside funds for this event. Last year we provided a bouncy jump castle (cost 300 euros) as well.
- b. End of Year BBQ is planned for Tuesday July 4th. We have set aside funds for this event as well. PTA provides drinks, hamburgers, fruit, and salad.
- c. Mr. Moreno and the Student Council will be having a meeting in April to discuss the students' wishes for Sports Day and the End of Year BBQ. He will report back to us in May regarding what kind of entertainment the students would like and what kind of food we should provide for these events.

4. Teacher Appreciation Gifts

- a. Typically these gifts have been given out at the beginning of the year, but due to leadership changes we are going to give the gifts at the end of the year.
- b. We are looking for gift ideas and for a PTA member to lead this project.
- c. We typically spend between 7 to 10 euros for each gift. There are approximately 85 staff members. Past gifts have been a RISS coffee mug and a big jar of jam (confituur)
- d. We would like to have the teacher appreciation gifts ready to give out on July 4th.
