



Academic Year 2023-24 The British International School of New York

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The British International School of New York, Upper School, is a comprehensive independent four-year program, enrolling 85 students in grades 9-12. The student body is very international and culturally diverse, containing students from 48 different countries. The school opened in the fall of 2006 and graduated its first senior class in spring of 2022. BIS-NY Upper School is accredited by Cambridge International Examinations (CIE) and holds memberships in the Council of British International Schools (COBIS) and New York State Association of Independent Schools (NYSAIS).

### [Curriculum](#)

Students take up to 10 Cambridge IGCSEs (International General Certificate in Secondary Education) for examination at the end of their Sophomore year and typically 3 or 4 Cambridge A-Levels (Advanced Level), for examination at the end of their Senior year. Some courses offer a staged assessment, meaning students sit “AS-Level” examinations at the end of their Junior year. All A-Level courses are studied over two years and final examinations are externally set and graded. A minimum of 5 IGCSEs and 3 AS or A Level passes are required for graduation.

IGCSE Levels: English Language, English Literature, Mathematics, Additional Mathematics, Biology, Chemistry, Physics, Computer Science, Geography, History, Visual Art, Drama, Music, Physical Education, French and Spanish.

A-Levels offered: Mathematics, Further Mathematics, Biology, Chemistry, Physics, Computer Science, English Literature, History, Geography, Visual Art, Music, Physical Education, Business, Psychology, French, Spanish and the International Project Qualification (IPQ).

All these courses are honors and very academic in content. There are no more challenging courses offered at the school. As a reflection of this, here is our GPA conversion scale for Cambridge high school grades:

### [Cambridge Examinations June 2023](#)

There were 30 candidates that took Cambridge IGCSE exams.

A total of 229 exams were taken in 16 subjects.

40% of the Cambridge IGCSE exams received grades of A\* or A.

There were 15 candidates that took Cambridge AS Level exams.

A total of 32 exams were taken in 9 subjects.

44% of the Cambridge AS Level exams received one of the top 3 grades.

There were 12 candidates that took Cambridge A-Level exams.

A total of 32 exams were taken in 15 subjects.

53% of the Cambridge A-Level exams received grades of A\* - B.
