As always, thank you for your input and for being a valuable partner to the Wausau School District.




#### John Muir Middle School Bus and Parent Pickup / Drop Off Routes During Construction



The front "circle drive" area will remain closed and fenced off for construction. As a result, we need to make changes to our drop-off/pick-up procedures. We anticipate long lines so please be patient and plan accordingly.







#### **Our #1 recommendation is to drop off at Marathon Park:**

We highly encourage all drop-off/pick-up of students to occur at alternate locations if possible, including Marathon Park, surrounding streets, etc. Dropping off/picking up at alternative locations will help with our traffic congestion problems and hopefully keep things moving safely.

- The main entrance will open as usual.
- Additional West gate access on 17th Ave. will be open by 7:00 AM.
- Note the drop-off and pick-up area within the park, to avoid traffic congestion at the main entrance.
- · All traffic must exit the park using the Garfield Ave. gate.
- Crossing guards will help your student safely cross at Stewart Avenue.


## John Muir Middle School Bus and Parent Pickup / Drop Off Routes During Construction

#### **Before-School Student Drop-Off**

- If you choose to drop your student off at school, please note the route has changed. The main entrance off S. 12th Avenue is still open. However, S. 12th will be CLOSED to Stewart Ave. eastbound traffic.
- Westbound access to S. 12th Ave. will remain open, meaning you CANNOT turn left onto S. 12th Avenue.
- When entering the property you will drive through our main parking lot and then over the new, temporary road along Stewart Avenue. Once you cross that new road a staff member will be directing vehicles for student drop-off, then directing which exit to use onto Stewart Avenue.
  - Driving this new route is single lane, one-way; vehicles will not be allowed to exit back onto S 12th Avenue.
  - No dropping off students in the parking lot or non-designated locations.
  - Please pull up as far as possible and watch for staff directing you.
  - Make sure your student is ready to exit the vehicle.
  - Please do not attempt to pull around other cars.
  - Dropping off on Callon Street and behind the building will not be permitted as bus drop-off will be occurring on that street.


## John Muir Middle School Bus and Parent Pickup / Drop Off Routes During Construction

PM Bus and Parent Drop Off Routes






#### **After-School Student Pickup**

- The parking lot and entrance to John Muir will be closed until 3:10 p.m.
- Please make arrangements to pick up your student at Marathon Park or another meeting location off of the John Muir campus. The same morning route will be open after school for pickup beginning at 3:10 p.m.
- After 3:10 p.m. you can enter the property through the main entrance off S 12th Avenue, drive through our main parking lot, and then over the new, temporary road along Stewart Avenue. Once you cross that new road you will be able to pick up your student on the side of the building, then exit onto Stewart Avenue.
- Driving this new route is single lane, one-way; vehicles will not be allowed to exit back onto S 12th Avenue.
- Please pull up as far as possible and watch for staff directing you.
- Please do not attempt to pull around other cars.



I joined the military immediately after graduation and enlisted in the US Army (Active Duty). I had multiple combat deployments to Iraq, a humanitarian deployment



to New Orleans for Hurricane Katrina, and a training deployment to Thailand in my 4-year enlistment. I attended UW-Stevens Point graduating in May 2011 with a double major in Broadfield Social Studies and Psychology with a minor in History. 
