Attached please find the financial report as of September 20, 2023 for fiscal year 2022-2023 which reflects expenditures and encumbrances of \$43,707,836 or 97.06% of the \$45,029,799 budget. Encumbrances of \$624,563 are currently open and included within the total expenditures. The impact of closing these encumbrances in the coming months will determine the final balance returned to the Town.

In brief, the analysis is as follows:

1. **BOTTOM LINE:** The financial report summarizes the expenditures as included in our financial system and reflects a remaining balance of \$1,321,963 as of the 9/20/23 print date. To date, no request to the Town Council has been made to transfer a portion of the anticipated surplus to the Unexpended Education Funds Account. The allowable transfer is limited to 2% of the budget, or \$900,595, with the overall account balance capped at \$2 million. With an account balance at 6/30/23 of \$1.59 million, the allowable contribution amount from the 2022-2023 surplus is \$411,462. This transfer would result in a return of approximately \$910,501 to the general fund balance. We are still closing out encumbrances- sums set aside during the year for anticipated costs, but not expended to date. Currently there are eighty outstanding purchase orders. Some encumbrances will be exhausted when year-end bills are received, but others may generate no additional costs, and should be closed, releasing their reserved funds back into the budget, to apply against other obligations. Thus, the attached financial report is really a "snapshot" of our financial status at present. It will continue to evolve, even though the actual fiscal year has concluded. Commentary follows on several account groups worthy of note.

SALARIES:

Salary accounts in total netted a positive balance of \$1,276,000 with budget savings in all but secretarial salaries, substitute teacher salaries, and transportation salaries. Budget savings in teacher salaries of \$778,000 and paraprofessionals of \$388,000 were the major contributors to the balance. Savings from replacements of teachers due to retirements and resignations, as well as unfilled positions and unpaid leaves for teachers throughout the year are reflected in the balance. Budget savings resulted from hourly paid and non-contracted employee groups not working the budgeted contractual hours. Additional budget savings were also realized in the ordinary course of business such as reimbursements from workers' compensation, grant offsets, unfilled positions, and docks in pay.

Three salary accounts ended the year with negative balances including:

Secretarial/Clerical (5121)- Secretarial salaries exceeded budget by \$(17,288) primarily due to pay adjustments resulting from the collective bargaining agreement between Killingly Board of Education and AFSCME Local 1303-149 of Council #4 and clerical and dispatching hours in the transportation department beyond contracted hours.

Transportation (5125)- Transportation salaries exceeded budget by \$(107,814) as was projected in the May 2023 report. The wage for bus drivers of \$25.00/hour pursuant to the collective bargaining agreement exceeded the wages budgeted of \$19.00-\$22.00/hour for 2022-2023 by approximately 25%.

Substitutes (5126)- Substitute teacher salaries exceeded budget by \$(208,816) which is in line with the \$(200K)-\$(260K) forecasted using the expenditure trends as included in the May 2023 report. The increase in substitute pay expenditures correlates to the budget savings in Teacher Salaries (5113) of \$778K and may be considered an offset in expenditures for positions which could not be filled with permanent employees.

BENEFITS:

As anticipated, benefits yielded a significant positive balance of \$785,000 primarily due to savings in health and dental insurance (5210) of \$588,000 and accompanying HSA Contributions (5212) of \$67,000 from budgeted insurance packages not taken by employees and enrollment changes through the year. Also, commensurate with the savings in salaries, payroll taxes FICA (5220) and Medicare (5225) realized budget savings of \$45,000 and \$37,000, respectively.

Unemployment Compensation (5250)- Expenditures of \$2,314 for unemployment compensation for 2022-2023 were an all-time low, leaving a line-item balance of \$47,686. Unemployment compensation is always unpredictable and ranged over the last twelve years from a high of \$124,000 for 2012-2013 to the low of \$2,314 for 2022-2023 with a median expenditure of \$41,000. The State of Connecticut rolled out a new tax and benefit system, ReEmployCT, in July 2022 which changed Killingly Public Schools from monthly to quarterly billing, increasing the period of uncertainty for charges. Charges for the first quarter of fiscal year 2024 are estimated at \$8,000.

OTHER:

Utilities (5410)- The 2022-2023 budget was prepared with the expectation natural gas service would be operational for Killingly High School and Killingly Central School by the end of summer 2022, which did not happen. The heating oil previously budgeted for Heat Energy (5620) was removed and replaced with natural gas budgeted in Utilities (5410). The resulting line-item surplus of \$377,000 is partially offset by the line-item deficit of \$(285,000) in Heat Energy.

Local Placement Tuition (5561) and Agency Placement Tuition (5562)- Outplacement tuition and related costs of \$4,752,172 exceeded the budgeted appropriation of \$4,574,412 requiring application of excess cost reimbursement of \$177,760. Total excess cost reimbursement of \$979,071 was received from the State for high-cost special education placements. The difference of \$801,311 will be retained by the Town.

Heat Energy (5620)- Oil and propane costs exceeded the line-item budget by \$(285,235). As explained in Utilities (5410), heating oil was neither budgeted nor contracted for, with the expectation Killingly High School and Killingly Central School would be using natural gas in 2022-2023. Due to unexpected conditions, natural gas service did not begin at either school. Oil purchases for 2022-2023 were made at market which ranged from \$2.82-\$4.03/gallon. The line-item deficit for Heat Energy is offset by the line-item surplus for unused natural gas in Utilities (5410).

Motor Fuels & Oils (5626)- As anticipated, gas, diesel, and diesel exhaust fluid (DEF) purchases from the Town exceeded the budget by \$(47,306). The per gallon charges were budgeted between \$1.20-\$1.30 lower than the actual charges.

The following accounts reflect deficits resulting from purchasing, in part to offset 2023-2024 budget reductions of \$601,031, and in an effort to replace aging and failing equipment and utilize existing funds to improve educational programming.

Contingency (5900)- The 2022-2023 budget was approved at \$1 over the 2021-2022 of \$45,029,798 in consideration of unexpended funds from prior years' appropriations. A portion of the reduction required to the Board of Education's proposed budget, or \$275,671, was allocated to the Contingency line item for funding from the Unexpended Education Funds account (non-lapsing fund) if needed. No supplemental funding was required.

2. NON-LAPSING ACCOUNT: To date, a request to the Town Council for a transfer of a portion of the estimated \$1.3M unexpended balance has not been made. Statutorily, the transfer may not exceed 2% of the appropriation, or \$900,595, and the account balance cannot exceed \$2M as authorized by the Town Council. The Unexpended Education Funds account balance, including encumbrances, as of 6/30/23 is estimated at \$1,588,538 which would allow for a maximum contribution of \$411,462, to be confirmed with the Town Finance Director.

- 3. <u>EDUCATION FINANCIAL SYSTEM (EFS):</u> The Education Financial System (EFS) data filing was certified and submitted to the State Department of Education on August 30, 2023.
- 4. <u>ANNUAL AUDIT</u>: Mahoney, Sabol & Company will once again be performing the annual Town audit. Preliminary audit work began in July with visits from audit staff. The required completion date is December 31, 2023.
- 5. **BUDGET TRANSFERS:** The financial report reflects a number of account deficits as detailed above. Other deficit accounts reflect year-end spending for which budget transfers were not made which has been customary practice as long as within the total budget appropriation.

Attached please find the financial report for the month of August, the second month of fiscal year 2023-2024, which reflects expenditures and encumbrances of \$4,874,539 or 10.41% of the \$46,805,118 budget. Also attached is the July 31, 2023 financial report for your reference.

1. <u>BUDGET STATUS:</u> At this time, review of the financial reports indicates no budget accounts of particular concern. Most accounts are at expected levels of expenditures and encumbrances.

SALARIES:

The expenditures include five payroll periods (out of 26) or 19.23% for our full year (twelve month) employees. The first teacher payroll of 2023-2024 will be in September. In general, salary accounts as of 8/31/23 reflect the staffing conditions with active employee turnover and unfilled positions leading to a lower-than-expected level of expenditures. Positions continue to be filled and arrangements made to cover vacancies with budgetary impacts yet to be determined. Student Services (5127) at 42.89% expended include payments for summer help in the Agriculture Education, Information Technology, and Operations and Maintenance departments.

BENEFITS:

Health/Dental Insurance (5210)- There were no contributions to the health insurance fund for 2023-2024 as of August 31, 2023 due to the number of enrollment changes during July and August. Three months of payments will be made in September.

HSA Contributions (Health Savings Account) (5212)- Contributions to health savings accounts as of August 31, 2023 totaling \$43,913 reflect the terms of the collective bargaining unit agreements. The collective bargaining unit agreement through June 30, 2025 for the custodians, secretaries, et al. requires 50% of the annual contribution to the health savings accounts to be deposited in July with the remaining 50% to be deposited in January 2024. The agreement through June 30, 2026 with supervisors requires 50% contribution to be deposited in July with the remaining 50% to be deposited in January 2024. The remaining units' agreements call for 50% of the annual contribution to be made in September.

Life Insurance (5213)- There were no life insurance payments made as of August 31, 2023 due to the number of enrollment changes during July and August. Three months of payments will be made in September.

HRA Funding (Health Reimbursement Account) (5218)- HRA funding is provided as an alternative to HSA contributions for employees enrolled in Medicare and ineligible to contribute to a health savings account. Health reimbursement account expenditures are recorded in the month incurred. There were no HRA expenditures recorded prior to the 8/31/23 report, but expenditures of \$40.55 incurred in July and August have been subsequently recorded in the applicable month.

Pension (5231)- Contribution to the defined benefit pension plan for non-certified staff is actuarially determined and will be booked by the Town by year-end.

Unemployment Compensation (5250)- The State of Connecticut rolled out a new tax and benefit system, ReEmployCT, in July 2022. As a reimbursable employer, Killingly Public Schools' billing was to be switched from monthly to quarterly. As of the end of August no invoices for unemployment compensation have been received or paid.

Workers' Compensation (5260)- The full year premium has been encumbered for 2023-2024, leaving an available balance of \$16,845. This balance is not expected to materially change.

OTHER:

Pupil Services (5323)- Pupil services include athletic-related payments for officials and trainers, as well as payments to post-graduate special education students in the vocational transition program. Expenditures totaling \$136.14 were made as of the 8/31/23 report.

Pupil Transportation (5510)- While no expenditures were made as of the 8/31/23 report, our reliance on outside transportation providers continues for much of the out-of-town special education runs and athletics transportation. The 2023-2024 line-item budget of \$35,000 was prepared with the assumption that most runs would be covered with indistrict staffing. For the most part, we are currently covering the regular education runs with in-district staffing. As in the past few years, transportation staffing remains a challenge. Currently we are experiencing driver absences for medical and personal issues. The financial impact is difficult to project, with both staffing and transportation needs evolving throughout the year. This is an area requiring continued monitoring.

Other Insurance & Judgments (5529)- \$14,000 was paid for the annual premium of the interscholastic sports accident policy.

Tuition (5560)- Tuition for magnet schools has not yet been encumbered, pending enrollment information from the various schools.

Local and Agency Placement Tuition (5561) and (5562)- As of the 8/31/23 report approximately \$1,500,000 of expenditures and encumbrances for local and agency placement tuition has been recorded for known placements. Related transportation costs have been encumbered in some cases, with other arrangements pending review. It is important to note that excess cost reimbursements for these placements have also not been calculated. Comparisons of expenditures and encumbrances from year to year at this early juncture may lead to unrealistic assumptions. Any differences could be due merely to timing issues in the recording of anticipated costs in the financial accounting system. Analysis of these accounts will be ongoing as the variables change throughout the year.

Heat Energy (5620)- The 2023-2024 budget was prepared with the expectation natural gas service would be operational for Killingly High School and Killingly Central School. The heating oil previously budgeted in this line item was removed and replaced with natural gas budgeted in Utilities (5410). Due to unexpected conditions, natural gas service has not begun at either school as of 8/31/23. It is expected natural gas service will be online for Killingly Central School for the heating season, with no need for heating oil purchases. Killingly High Schools' conversion has been extended due to the discovery of unknown conditions requiring additional work. The timeline for completion of this work is unknown, as the scheduling must consider the occupancy of the school. It can be anticipated that heating oil will be needed for some portion of the year.

Killingly Public Schools has developed a plan to utilize tutors, specifically in the K-4 buildings to provide in class and pull-out support for our EL learners. This support will be connected to the CELP Standards and will provide the young learners with opportunities to have guided practice around Oral Language, Listening, Speaking as well as Reading and Writing possibilities. We recognize after thorough examination of our LAS Links results, that our students are lacking in oral language exposure in the K and 1 classrooms and writing specifically in our Grades 2-5 classrooms. With this information as our guide, we have purchased materials that will help support our EL students. We have also developed the EL plans together with the teachers with this focus.

2. Describe how the district will provide effective professional development to classroom teachers (including teachers in classroom settings that are not the settings of language instruction educational programs), principals and other school leaders, other administrators, and other school or community-based organizational personnel.

We will provide PD throughout the school year either in our Early Release Day schedule or on the PD days built into our school schedules. This PD will vary based on school need and will be delivered by the Reading Specialists in the school district. We will continue to research best practice in the area of Oral Language for our youngest EL students, while we continue our work with Core Strategies that work across the board for all students.

3.	Describe how the district will promote and implement other effective activities and strategies that enhance or supplement language instruction educational programs for English learners, which (a) shall include parent, family and community engagement activities; and (b) may include strategies that serve to coordinate and align related programs.
	We have prepared Literacy Nights with attention geared for our EL parents. We are currently working with our Public Library in the area of storytelling and read alouds for our students. Schools send home a newsletter with many literacy websites and suggestions for games that can be done at home to promote thinking and speaking.
