

- Prepared for college in terms of reading, writing, time management etc...
- · Develop problem-solving abilities
- Classes are weighted at 5 points...helps GPA
- Provides an opportunity to take college level courses

What Parents Need to Know

- AP Teachers cover the required skills and content, but not every possible exam topic
- Classes are year long students not allowed to drop class...regardless of grade earned
- ALL registered students must take the AP exam
- Scores on a 1-5 scale
- Students are excused from classes on the day of AP Exam

Important Information

- Every assignment counts there are no "Throwaway"
 assignments in AP. Everything needs to be completed to a high degree of mastery
- Time management is essential help and reinforce scheduling study time daily, along with family and rest
- Attendance is Key so much material is covered each class, every absent day makes it more difficult for students to keep on track
- Students must build and foster relationships with the teacher
- This year there will be a late fee if AP Test are not paid by December 18, 2023

About AP Scores

Advanced Placement (AP) | CSU

AP Exams are scored on a scale of 1 to 5. Many U.S. colleges grant credit and/or advanced placement (that means they let you skip the equivalent course once you get to college) for scores of 3 and above.

Web-Based Programs

- Khan academy and AP Central have self-paced assignments that correlate with the AP suggested syllabus.
- All assigned videos, homework, and quizzes must be completed on-time. If these electronic assignments are completed on time, students will have a better understanding of the physical classroom environment.
- Khan academy has specific follow-up videos to meet the remedial needs of individual students.
- Notes should be taken on each web-based assignment!

This table shows the recommendation that each AP score offers about how qualified you are to receive college credit and placement if you earn that score. It also shows the equivalent college course grade for each score.

| AP Exam Score | Recommendation | College Course Grade Equivalent |
|---------------|--------------------------|---------------------------------|
| 5 | Extremely well qualified | A+ or A |
| 4 | Very well qualified | A-, B+, or B |
| 3 | Qualified | B-, C+, or C |
| 2 | Possibly qualified | |
| 1 | No recommendation | |

- Students will receive updates of all AP matters through google classroom and via email
- Fee Reduction may be applied, if qualified
- Exams begin week of May 6, 2023
- Exams are MANDATORY




AP Payment Options AP Fees due by December 18, 2023
