8.50 Child Protection

The Board of Trustees of The American International School/Dhaka (the "Board" and the "School", respectively) recognizes that child protection and welfare considerations permeate all aspects of school life and must be reflected in all of the school's policies, practices and activities.

The goal of this policy is to ensure that all parties work together to ensure the safety and well-being of children. This policy recognizes the proactive training that AISD must undertake to educate students, parents, faculty and staff about child protection. It also stresses the process and procedures to be followed in cases of suspected child abuse, as the Board adopts the principals stated in the AISD Child Protection Manual which will be reviewed on an annual basis and updated if needed. Any changes to the AISD Child Protection Manual must be approved by the Board.

Confidentiality: The School will fully respect confidentiality requirements in dealing with child protection matters.
