## School Mission Statement

Cherokee High School strives to meet the social, emotional and cognitive needs of all students to prepare them to become productive members of an ever-changing and diverse society.

## School Improvement Goal 1

Starting in the 2023-2024 school year, CHS will increase participation in future-readiness programs by 1% yearly over 3 years as measured by CCRPI Readiness indicators.

## School Improvement Action Plan

- Improve **Student Advisement Processes** and **Academic Progress Monitoring**.
- Develop opportunities through **Feedback** for students to create and achieve short-term and long-term goals and reflect on their individual progress.

## School Improvement Goal 2

Starting in the 2022-2023 school year, CHS will increase the overall Four-Year Graduation Rate by 1% (from 84.2% in 2021, 86.1% in 2022) by increasing the number of students who are on-track providing supports to targeted subgroups.

## School Improvement Action Plan

- Monitor student progress toward **Pathway Completion** (i.e. four-year graduation plans).
- Develop students' **Career and Future Readiness** by developing an understanding of student aptitudes, interests, and pathways to various future outcomes.
- Develop a **Sense of Individual and Community Leadership** which reinvigorates Warrior culture.
