Please read the <u>pick-up and drop-off procedures</u> on our website carefully. We need your help in implementing these in order to provide a safe environment for all of Bagby students. We are a busy school and congestion at drop off and pick up times is an ongoing challenge. We need your help! Please consider participating in our <u>Walk N' Roll Program</u> as many families find it the most efficient and relaxing way to get your child to and from school.

Campus safety is an ongoing top priority for the district and our school. Access to the campus during the school day is available only through the school office where we will request that you sign in and get a badge if you will be on the school grounds.
