





## **CSD LCAP Updates**







## What were the big ideas behind the Local Control and Accountability Plan?

- Increased flexibility in the use of state funds by replacing "categorical funds" that could only be used for specific purposes with Local Control Funding Formula funds.
- Required districts to write a three year plan that shows how funds will be used to improve student achievement.
- Requires districts to align the use of resources (\$\$) with student needs.

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


Every Student Success Act (ESSA) Requirements

COMPREHENSIVE SUPPORT AND IMPROVEMENT (CSI) PROMPTS IN THE LCAP The ESSA requires that the State Educational Agency (SEA) approve school plans for schools identified for CSI.

To address this requirement the CDE proposed to add three CSI Summary prompts to the Plan Summary section of the LCAP template.


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- Consolidated Application
- Must be approved by the local governing board.
- Submitted to the CDE via by July 1, 2019.
- CDE will review to ensure that responses address ESSA requirements.


