- 1 To ensure academic success for every student attending one of our schools.
- 2 To make sure that our school facilities and school grounds are safe, modern, and equipped to provide the best educational environment possible.

Our Needs

- ► MODERNIZE classrooms, labs, and facilities needed to support high-quality instruction in math, science, engineering, technology, music, and visual and performing arts.
- ▶ REPAIR aging infrastructure by removing asbestos and lead paint, and repair deteriorating plumbing, restrooms, leaky roofs, drinking fountains, and electrical and HVAC systems.
- ▶ **UPDATE** classrooms and computer systems to keep pace with technology and create modern, multi-use classrooms to support hands-on instruction and learning-by-doing.
- UPGRADE computers and technology needed for students to take classes, interact with teachers, and complete assignments online if they can't be there in person.
- ► IMPROVE student safety, campus security, and access to school facilities for students with disabilities.
