Our Plan




- Create new, sustainable sources of revenue through underutilized property.
- CSD is not "selling" its land but is proposing to exchange and/or lease a portion of the closed Metzler site in order to create a long term, sustainable source of income necessary to help educate our students.
- CSD is partnering with a local builder, Robson Homes, to develop a well thought out plan that will be attractive, as well as enhance the surrounding community.
