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COMMUNITY RELATIONS Volunteer Assistance

- I. The Board recognizes that the public has resources of training, experience, and energy necessary to the schools. Utilization of these resources enriches the educational programs for students and is helpful to staff and the volunteers themselves. The Board intends that this involvement be a vital part of our commitment to quality education.
- II. The Superintendent shall, therefore, cause District-wide guidelines to be developed and shall ensure the development of individual school plans, with significant and meaningful community involvement.
- III. Included in the goals of the programs shall be: lowering of children-adult ratio, building confidence and communication between home and school, and educating parents--both in skills needed in the schools and in skills needed for effective parenting.
- IV. The Superintendent or designee shall establish procedures to protect the safety of students and adults. Procedures shall be in accordance with the laws related to tuberculosis testing and will also include laws related to criminal record checks and any other applicable laws.
- V. Volunteers shall act in accordance with District policies, regulations and school rules. They shall be provided with information about school/classroom goals, programs and practices and shall receive an orientation and/or other training related to their specific responsibilities as appropriate. The Superintendent or designee will develop a Volunteer Code of Conduct which will be reviewed and signed by all volunteers prior to volunteering in our schools.
