COMMUNITY RELATIONS

Volunteer Assistance

Schools in the Cambrian School District shall encourage community involvement and participation in their daily educational programs and other school sponsored events; i.e., Home & School Club, after school enrichment programs, sports, etc. Such involvement may utilize volunteers as aides in the classroom, library, resource centers, office, health program, school maintenance and improvement projects, as resource people, and in other areas of the school program. These duties shall not include assignment of final grades to students.

- I. Volunteers may supervise students during lunch and/or breakfast periods or may serve under the immediate supervision and direction of certificated personnel to perform tasks which assist certificated personnel in the performance of teaching and administrative responsibilities. Teachers and administrators will use discretion in the assignment of volunteers, and at no time should anyone serving in a volunteer capacity be left alone with a child.
- II. A person who is required to register as a sex offender pursuant to Penal Code 290 shall not serve as a volunteer.
- III. No volunteer shall be allowed to provide supervision or instruction of students unless he/she has submitted evidence of an examination within the past 60 days to determine that he/she is free of active tuberculosis, and in accordance with Education Code 49406 volunteers who test negative shall thereafter be required to submit a tuberculosis test every four years.
