COMMUNITY

Public Conduct on School Property

- I. The Board of Trustees of the Cambrian School District recognizes the need for a clear understanding of those types of behavior considered wholly unacceptable within the Cambrian School District.

- II. The Board wishes to indicate to staff, students and visitors alike that any of the following violations of orderly conduct are to be considered cause for prompt and diligent corrective action on the part of the appropriate officials, including disciplinary proceedings and the bringing of criminal charges where appropriate:
 - A. Obstruction or disruption of any authorized Cambrian School District activity, including those of auxiliary organizations; e.g., Home and School Club.
 - B. Obstruction of either pedestrian or vehicular traffic on Cambrian School District owned or controlled property.
 - C. Physical abuse or detention of any member of the Cambrian School District at any location or of any other person while that person is on Cambrian School District owned or controlled property.
 - D. Theft of or damage to property of any person while that property is on Cambrian School District owned or controlled buildings and grounds.
 - E. Conduct which endangers the health or safety of any person while on Cambrian School District owned or controlled property or at any Cambrian School District sponsored or supervised function.
 - F. Unauthorized entry to or use of any Cambrian School District facilities, including buildings, grounds and equipment.
 - G. Failure to comply with directions of a school official or his/her designee(s) while acting in the performance of his/her duties.

- H. Disorderly conduct, breach of the peace, and aiding, abetting or procuring another to breach the peace of Cambrian School District owned or controlled property or at any Cambrian School District sponsored or supervised functions.
- I. Possession of alcohol, illegal and/or controlled substances, imitation controlled substances, imitation controlled substances or drug paraphernalia. J. Possession of a weapon.
